


Total Activities Per Year



Key Results

Period: January 2020 - September 2022

- 683 B2B meetings organized through the participation of SMEs in trade fairs and matchmaking events
- 16 SMEs made transactions (of which 50% women led)
- Over USD 485K funds leveraged by SMEs though purchases and investments (of which USD 145K are from women led SMEs)
- 34 SMEs made operational or managerial changes thanks to the intervention (of which 32% women led)
- 18 policies, strategies, negotiations and administrative decisions in which public sector institutions have considered private sector inputs






Total Beneficiaries Supported by Organization Type

- 6 policy position papers developed to improve advocacy and policy making on agricultural trade














Total Activities Per Year Period: January 2020 - September 2022



Total Beneficiaries Supported by Organization Type



 <u>207 producer organizations</u> in the mango and onion value chains have been grouped into cooperative organizations through WACOMP support



 More than 41,882 producers in the mango and onion value chains are now represented in large cooperatives



 <u>827</u> co-operators operating in the mango and onion value chains have seen their capacities strengthened in production and/or management and marketing thanks to WACOMP



 15 SMEs/startups offering digital Agritech solutions supported to facilitate their access to markets



<u>lapprenticeship and internship programme</u> has been set up for the ICT sector.



8 ICT incubators have improved their capacity to mentor digital SMEs
